WHO WE ARE

Spirit of America is a citizen-funded 501c3 nonprofit. Following the attacks of 9/11, our founder was inspired by a simple idea: private citizens can support the missions of our troops by filling the gaps in what government can do. We are a citizen service organization that strengthens America's security. We have been recognized by Congress for "supporting the missions of deployed United States personnel around the world." No one else has achieved that distinction.

WHAT WE DO

Spirit of America provides flexible private assistance in response to local needs identified by deployed US troops and diplomats. We provide expertise, humanitarian and economic assistance, and equipment needed by US partner forces. We only provide assistance to support the safety and success of deployed US personnel and the local people and partners they seek to help.

Spirit of America has an unprecedented partnership with the US military. Our all-veteran field team works on the front lines alongside American troops and diplomats. We listen to what they say is needed. We develop solutions and, using private funding and private sector speed, we deliver exactly the assistance that's needed.

The world today demands that citizens participate to secure the blessings of liberty and the promise of a free and better life. America was founded on citizen service; ordinary Americans doing their part. We are citizens serving the nation: patriotism without politics.

Saving lives and limbs



We responded to needs identified by US Special Operations in Iraq by providing metal detectors to their Kurdish Peshmerga partners. The metal detectors are used to find roadside bombs.

Preventing war in West Africa



To help US Special Operations prevent war in Niger, we met livestock health and youth employment needs in key tribal areas. We funded a livestock vaccination campaign and veterinary scholarships for youth.

Answering Russian aggression & propaganda



In response to US Army Europe and the US Ambassador to Ukraine, SoA funded a radio station that meets the information needs of Ukrainian soldiers on the front lines of a war launched by Russia.

NOT NEUTRAL

Most organizations that provide assistance overseas are neutral. As a matter of principle and doctrine, they do not take a side and will not directly support the work of US personnel. Spirit of America is not neutral. We take the side of America's troops and diplomats. We only provide assistance in support of their safety and success, and the local people and partners they seek to help. We are also not political. We take no position on policy or politics: when America's men and women are sent to serve abroad, we support them, and help them return whole and proud of their success.
