Our Work



Saving lives and helping Ukraine

In partnership with the US military, we have delivered \$63+ million in protective, nonlethal aid to Ukrainian soldiers defending Ukraine against Russian aggression, helping them liberate territory and saving thousands of lives.



Strengthening Taiwan's security

We are helping the Taiwanese people protect their security and democracy by mobilizing civilian-led crisis response networks, training first responders, and strengthening the government's capacity to address crises.



Promoting security and stability in Iraq and Syria

To strengthen security and preserve stability in the Middle East, we are helping our troops, diplomats, and local partners counter extremism, save lives, and create opportunity in Iraqi Kurdistan and northeast Syria.



Stopping the spread of terrorism in West Africa

The Central Sahel region is the global epicenter of terrorism. We are helping US troops diminish the power of extremist groups by strengthening communities and partners on the frontlines.
